CLUB BOATS

The club has a selection of dinghies for hire (TO MEMBERS ONLY) and the Bosun is required to take responsibility for the hire and return of the club boats.

A copy of the hire form is shown below, which will help you to complete your duty. Please arrive at the club one hour before club racing and stay until all boats are returned at 5pm. You are responsible for ensuring all club boats are hired and returned according to the hire agreement shown below. You are also requested to tidy the Brown Shed as required. If time permits please use your time at the club to help sailors in particular the single-handers with their trolleys when launching and recovering. Or collect rubbish from the beach, dinghy - park and camping field. Black bin bags are stored in the cleaning cupboard at the top of the stairs by the ladies changing room. The OOD can issue the key. The club co-ordinator will let you know if any boats are pre booked.

Note to Bosun: The Committee have agreed to trial the hire of the club Fevas and Teras in 2hr sessions for £10. The Bosun is requested to rig a club Feva and position the boat on the beach with the information sign which can be found on the wall in the Bar stockroom. The Bosun should make sure the Feva is de-rigged and packed away at the end of the day.

Sailing Kit:

- **Toppers are on racks in Brown Shed. Sails on masts ready to go. Rudders and daggerboard in hull.**
- **Fevas locked by fuel locker. Key in key press (see OOD).
Fevas sails rudders and dagger boards are stored in brown shed.**
- **There are two types of feva main sail. XL is the big one and clear. Soft sail is yellow and white traditional look.**
- **Bosun Workshop in brown shed; See OOD for lock code**

All hire forms should be placed in the blue folder which is kept in the bar stockroom.

Please inform the OOD when boats are hired and fees paid as this information should be recorded on the OOD return form.

Dinghy Hire Rules

- 1 Boats are issued by the Club Bosun.
- 2 Before hire is permitted the Dinghy Hire agreement form **must** be signed by the adult or parent /guardian.
- 3 The adult or parent/guardian takes full responsibility for the hire of the boat and the child's sailing.
- 4 Adequate buoyancy and appropriate clothing **must** be worn.
- 5 **Hire Charges:**

THERE IS NO CHARGE TO USE THE CLUB BOATS FOR THE JUNIOR RACES BUT CHARGES APPLY THERAFTER.

- 6 Each dinghy and its equipment is colour / number coded.
The Hirer must rig, de-rig, rinse off and return the dinghy to the shed ensuring that the colour/ number coded equipment matches the colour/ number coded boat. Everything must be packed away to the Club Boatswain's satisfaction.
- 7 The hirer has a duty to take care of the club equipment. PTO for condition before and after use - replacement parts are expensive.
- 8 The sailing area for the dinghies shall be:
 - a) The area defined by the sewer-pipe to Afterbarn to North Hover and to the beach.

- b) The race course.
- c) The route of the Saildays / Sailaways.
